We always regard children as very special patients and do everything to make their visits as pleasant and enjoyable as possible. Our main aim is to help them form good dental habits which will prevent problems with their teeth in later life.

Choosing The Best Way To Pay

After your teeth have been examined and a treatment plan has been agreed, you will be given an estimate of the cost of the work to be done.

Payment is due on each day of treatment. In certain circumstances you may be required to pay the full cost before treatment commences. You can pay by cash, credit or debit card.

If you qualify for free treatment under the NHS, please inform us before treatment begins. If you are under 18 or under 19 in full-time education you can qualify for free NHS dental treatment. If you are worried about the cost of treatment, or find any point about the charges difficult to understand, please let us know.

We have several Denplan schemes, which spread the cost of Dental treatment over the year. Please ask at Reception for details.

Appointments

You can make an appointment by telephone or you can call in to reception. Our regular appointment times are given on page 9.

Please allow at least 24 hours notice if you have to cancel an appointment. We might make a charge if you do not give reasonable notice.

Once your treatment has been completed, we encourage you to come back to the Practice at regular intervals, to see that everything is going well.

Your next visit can be arranged before you leave the surgery. Text message reminders can be sent to you a few days before your next appointment.

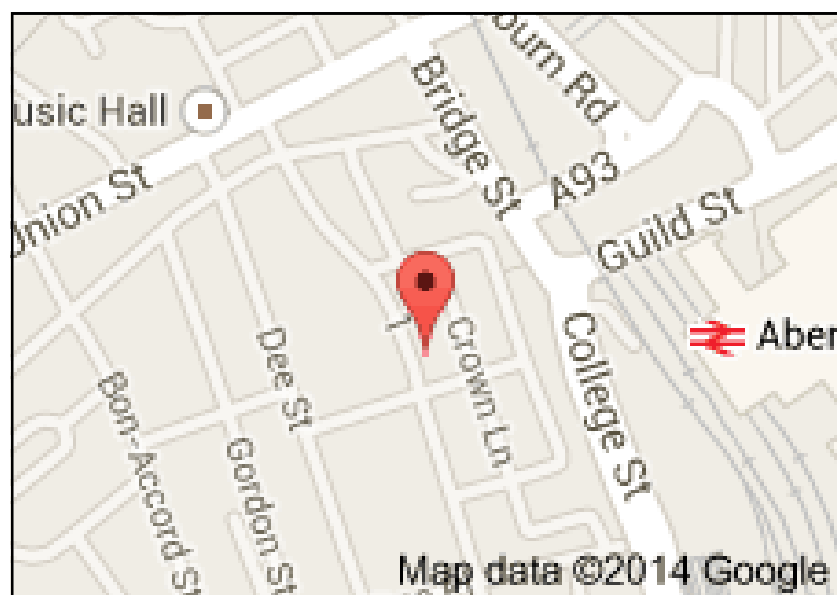
How to Register
